Denominational Affairs

As part of these endeavors DA recruits for and forwards nominations to the Board for UUA East Region Delmarva Cluster Representatives and UUA General Assembly (GA) delegates. In addition, DA facilitates the East Region's Chalice Lighters program.

Of special note, this year DA is introducing to the congregation information about proposed changes to Article 2 of the UUA bylaws (our UUA Principles reside in this article). Next year, 2024 DA will do the same with the rest of the UUA's bylaws.
