- Responsibilities: Coordinate and develop all communication vehicles that inform the congregation and the larger community about UUSD's vision, mission, and activities through: Publications including the weekly eNews, Sunday service reminders, and eBlasts; Publicity for UUSD events and activities in the local media; Outreach to the public and congregation through the Website (uussd.org) and Social Media; work of the Photo Team in capturing photos and preparing slide show videos to tell UUSD stories; creative Graphic Design to promote activities and events; and Copy Editing to assure accuracy of information and style.  - Join the Graphics Team. Design flyers, icons for use in publications, and brochures. Previous graphic design software experience helpful.

 - o Join the Social Media Team. Prepare activity, event, and inspirational posts.
 - o Join the Publicity Team. Prepare press releases and public service announcements.

Denominational Affairs

• **Responsibilities:** Denominational Affairs (DA) is responsible for linkage (both ways) between the UUA Eastern Region (ER) and the UUA National. This entails some specific duties and duties that come up from time to time. It is DA's specific responsibility to keep the congregation and its leaders informed about pertinent activities in the UU wider world. DA promotes regional and national meetings and assemblies. As part of these endeavors DA recruits for and

forwards nominations to the Board for UUA East Region Delmarva Cluster Representatives and UUA General Assembly (GA) delegates. In addition, DA facilitates the East Region's Chalice Lighters program. Of special note, this year DA is introducing to the congregation information about proposed changes to Article 2 of the UUA bylaws (our UUA Principles reside in this article). In 2024 DA will do the same with the rest of the UUA's bylaws.

Membership Committee

Property Management Committee

- **Responsibilities:** PMC manages all aspects of the UUSD facility maintenance, repair, improvements, utilities, service contracts, etc. PMC must react to immediate needs while planning for ongoing costs and staying within an allocated budget. PMC manages Kitchen, A/V, Landscaping, and Energy subcommittees.
- Volunteer Opportunities: PMC's mission is essential, but membership is all volunteers, so need for communication and redundancy is ongoing. Opportunities are learning building systems and helping with operation/maintenance, reacting to immediate needs, managing service calls, assisting with PMC communications (e.g. minutes, reports, notices), strategic documentation of "Facility Operation."

Safer Congregation Committee

- **Responsibilities:** Our charge is to review and develop procedures that keep our community safe. We review practice and procedures to deal with natural disasters, i.e., flood hurricanes, etc.; and internal and external threats to the community, such as fires, illness or accident, and vandalism, or hostile intrusion. We review and update UUSD's Emergency Response Manual. We work closely with the Membership Committee to revise the roles and responsibilities of our Greeters and Ushers. We hold trainings and drills as needed.
- Volunteer Opportunities: We are a small committee of 6 people as well as our Safety Response Volunteer team of 8+ volunteers. We welcome visitors who may be interested in joining our committee.
