In accordance with UUSD Bylaws, Section 7.4, 1) g), "The BOT shall manage the sharing of any sensitive financial data."

Each of us will have our unique circumstances to consider in making a pledge. This Generosity Guide is a tool to help you translate your pledge into real dollars.

- RED contributors come from households that have a source of steady income—a job that pays well, a good pension, or income-producing assets. You are fortunate to have discretionary income. If so, your household is red. A red pledge may be \$5,000 or more.
- MAGENTA is similar to red but a little bluer. Magenta means you and perhaps others in your household have a reasonably high income. You may be magenta, rather than red, if you have kids in college, high medical bills, or other obligations that reduce your discretionary spending. A magenta pledge may be \$3,000-\$5,000.
- PURPLE comes in many shades. Purple may be retired and living on a fixed income. Purple may have income that varies from year to year. Purple may be helping other members of the family or be a single-income family. A purple pledge may be \$1,000-\$3,000.
- BLUE does not have a lot of money to spare.
 Blue may be paying off loans or living on a
 very modest income. Blue is beautiful and
 a valued part of our UUSD community. Blue
 pledges may be \$300-\$1,000.
- LIGHT BLUE is in a different situation financially and may need to pledge less than \$300 annually. Light Blue is a valued part of our Beloved Community.
